Further criteria: Applicants must be: 1) 2018-2019 Graduating Senior 2) Attend school in Tarrant County 3) Must possess a 3.75 G.P.A. or higher 4) Completed some Advanced Placement and/or Honors Classes 5) Must have been accepted to a college/university/trade school.

Determination Scholarship

This scholarship is awarded to a graduating high school senior. The award recognizes a student that has excelled academically in spite of hardship and/or challenges and demonstrates leadership and community service.

Further criteria: Applicants must be: 1) 2018-2019 Graduating Senior 2) Must possess a 2.75 G.P.A. or higher 3) Must have been accepted to a college/university/trade school.
