Four Texas Campuses Recognized at 35th Annual TABSE State Conference

(San Antonio, TX) The Texas Alliance of Black School Educators (TABSE) is announcing the latest round of Dr. Jay Cummings Demonstration Schools. These campuses are a select group of high performing majority-minority schools from across Texas that will share instructional strategies and programs that have helped their schools close achievement gaps for African American and Hispanic students.

The 2020 Dr. Jay Cummings Demonstration Schools are:

Hoffman Middle School, Aldine ISD Foster Elementary School, Houston ISD Edward Titche Elementary School, Dallas ISD Williams Elementary School, Lamar Consolidated ISD

Districts submitted an application that allowed them to highlight student performance, culture, and climate, educational systems, and procedures; a committee of education leaders reviewed applications and announced the demonstration schools during the 35th annual TABSE state conference held in San Antonio.

"It is important to shine a light on the schools and districts that are leading the way in improving academic outcomes for students of color," said Dr. David Harris, TABSE President. "These demonstration schools will share resources, information, best practices, and even allow campus visits to build capacity in other campus leadership teams."
