- > Base decisions on available facts in each situation; to vote my honest conviction in every case, not be influenced by bias of any kind; to abide by and support the final majority decision of the affiliate and/or TABSE board;
- Recognize the professional responsibility to the development, improvement, and execution of programs to strengthen the organization;
- > Hold inviolate any confidential information entrusted by me;
- Avoid the engagement in or countenance of any exploitation of the organization and refrain from using my membership in any matter that is improper or illegal;
- Maintain high standards of personal conduct;
- Maintain high regard for one another by avoiding derogatory, demeaning and insulting remarks and being polite, kind, honest, fair and conciliatory;
- Recognize and practice the importance my membership to understand, seek and evaluate the programmatic functions as it is to plan for the business aspect of the organization.
- As an individual member, I have no legal authority to speak on behalf of the organization (i.e.: media, press conferences, etc.)
